



Guide To Actions and Consequences: Martin

***For ease of use we recommend launching ACTIONS AND CONSEQUENCES: MARTIN GAME and reading the instructions below whilst playing through the game.**

You will need to use the mouse to navigate around the online interactive whiteboard.

The ACTIONS AND CONSEQUENCES: MARTIN GAME is about making the right decisions as a young person. Martin lives in Belfast, where the political and social issues makes making the right decision even more difficult. The game aims to highlight these difficulties whilst raising awareness of the negative influence of drugs, violence and alcohol. As well as this it also showcases the **Midnight Street Soccer** project which is supported by money raised through Sport Relief.

The game is designed to be played as either a group or individually. Your student(s) are presented with a scenario, and a choice to make at the end of it. They can to say **YES** or **NO** to that choice, and depending on the answer they give will be taken to another scenario. If they make the right choices, Martin will progress through to finish the game healthy and safe, with the opportunity to aspire to a positive future.

Along the way your students will see **Issue Cards** pop up, if they click on these they will be given more in depth information about specific issues such as drug abuse and alcoholism.
